Plot Synopsis

The Biblical saga of Joseph and his coat of many colors comes to vibrant life in this delightful musical parable. Joseph, his father's favorite son, is a boy blessed with prophetic dreams.

Cost of a Musical

Creating a community musical theater production can be a rewarding but costly endeavor.

Here's a breakdown of what it typically involves:

- 1. Rights and Royalties: The largest expense often comes from securing rights to perform the musical, which can range from hundreds to several thousand dollars depending on the show's popularity. Price for Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat: \$9,000
- 2. Venue: Renting a space for rehearsals and performances adds up. Costs can vary significantly based on location and the size of the venue, but is normally in the thousands.

Price for Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat: \$14,000

3. Sets and Costumes: These can be created or rented. Building sets and costumes can be cheaper but requires skilled volunteers and materials.

4. Technical Equipment: Lighting and sound equipment rental can be pricey. If the venue doesn't provide these, it could increase production costs substantially.

5. Promotion: Marketing the show through flyers, posters, and social media ads is crucial for good attendance. Budgeting for advertising is essential.

Price for Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat: \$2,000

6. Miscellaneous: Don't forget about makeup, props, insurance, and possible stipends for directors or musicians.

Price for Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat: \$15,000
